

Stinsford Parish Council

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting Held on Monday 12th September 2011, at 7.00pm in the Old Library, Kingston Maurward College

Present: Mr D Ruston (Chairman), Mr G Armstrong, Mr M Clarke, Mrs C Davison, Mr H Grenville-Jones and Mrs P Pollard

In attendance: Mrs V Gifford (Clerk) and 2 members of public.

Public Discussion Period

No matters were raised:

40 Declarations of Interest

40.1 Cllrs Clarke and Davison declared a personal interest in any matters relating to Kingston Maurward College.

40 Apologies for absence

41.1 The absence of Cllr D Pain was **approved**. Apologies were also received from Cllrs East and Chisholm (District Councillors) and Cllr Haynes (County Councillor)

41 SPEAKER – Mr Mark James, Senior Liaison Manager, Olympic Delivery Authority – Olympic Games 2012 – Proposals for temporary Park and Ride provision at Kingston Maurward College

41.1 Mr James advised the meeting that the Olympic Delivery Authority were committed to work with and consult the Parish Council. He advised the meeting of the proposals for the Park and Ride at Kingston Maurward College and the planning application would be sent to West Dorset District Council within the next few weeks.

42 Minutes of previous Meetings

42.1 It was **resolved** that the minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on 11th July 2011 were a true record and signed by the Chairman.

43 Matters arising from above minutes

43.1 The following matters were discussed:

- Cllr Armstrong reported that work following the Annual Inspection Report of the Play Area had been completed.

44 Proposal from Kingston Maurward College

44.1 Cllr Davison suggested that in view of the lack of a community building within the Parish, there could be the possibility of the College and Parish Council working together to provide a joint use building. The college building in question was in disrepair and needed a complete rebuild, and had been used many years ago for community events. The Parish Council **AGREED** that this proposal had potential and agreed that further work should be carried out to provide further details and funding.

45 Finance

45.1 The following items of expenditure were **resolved**:

- £970.20 Mrs V Gifford, Clerks Salary £839.84 + Operational Expenses £50 + Expenses £80.36

- £209.80 HMRC – PAYE
- 45.2 The Council considered the letter from Dorset County Council regarding a contribution to Superfast Broadband. It was agreed to invite the writer to the next meeting to gain more information and costs involved.
- 45.3 The Clerk reminded the meeting to consider any possible expenditure for the next financial year in readiness for setting the budget at the next full meeting.

46 Planning Matters

- 46.1 Planning Consultation: 1/D/11/000996 – Greenwood Cottage, Bockhampton Lane, Lower Bockhampton – Replace outbuilding with timber shed – The Council resolved to **SUPPORT** this application.
- 46.2 Planning Consultation: 1/D/11/001263 – Unit 9, Lakeside Industrial Estate, St Georges Road, Dorchester – Install 10 solar photovoltaic units to roof of existing industrial unit - The Council resolved to **SUPPORT** this application.

47 Consultations

- 47.1 DCC Day Services Consultation – it was **AGREED** that cuts to this service were not acceptable. Cllr Armstrong agreed to attend the future consultation meeting and then construct a response to the consultation with the Clerk.
- 47.2 Bournemouth, Poole & Dorset Minerals and Waste Development Framework – it was noted that there was significant gravel within the parish and its extraction would severely impact on agriculture, ecology and sustainability. It was also agreed that there should be regulation of traffic through Lower Bockhampton.
- 47.3 WDDC – New Local Plan Consultation – It was **AGREED** that Cllr Clarke would attend the consultation and report back.

48 Traffic Management/Road Safety/ORN

- 48.1 It was noted that the ODA application would be a further vehicle to highlight problems.
- 48.2 The Clerk advised that she had received a phone call regarding increase of traffic and speed through Lower Bockhampton from a parishioner. It was noted that the Localism Bill gave an indication that local councils would be able to set local speed limits if it proceeded through Parliament. It was agreed that a one way system would cause difficulties for residents, however it was agreed to pursue 'Unsuitable for traffic' signs at Cuckoo Lane and the Clerk would endeavour to find out how the local speed gun system was working in a neighbouring parish.

49 Footpaths and Cyclepaths

- 49.1 There were no matters to report.

50 Comprehensive Spending Review

- 50.1 Dorset County Council – Cllr Haynes had provided a written report which was circulated.
- 50.2 West Dorset District Council – A reminder of the New Local Plan consultation.
- 50.3 Kingston Maurward College – Cllr Davison had no new matters to update the meeting

51 Clerks Items

- 51.1 It was agreed to follow up the Diamond Jubilee at the next meeting
- 51.2 It was **AGREED** that the anti virus software on the parish council laptop should be updated for a further 2 years.
- 51.3 Details of the DAPTC AGM had been circulated.
- 51.4 It was **AGREED** that the Parish Council should support Maiden Newton Parish Council in a Lengthsman Scheme.
